Live webinar training sessions with a U.S. Coast Guard Licensed Maritime Training Instructors will be delivered online weekly via WebEx and a wide range of activities, assignments, tutorials and assessments will be delivered online via AVTECOnline.

Upon successful **completion of the Nautical Skills class**, HS students (and HS Teachers) are **eligible to receive \$\$tuition, room & board\$\$ funds** to assist them with the completion of a wide range of USCG Approved Courses at AVTEC. Many Alaskan Students have already become fully licensed, highly employable professional Merchant Mariners while still in High School, **completely debt free!**
